


Office architecture is based on flexible floor plans beyond the isolationist nuclear family apartment that still dominates most of urban housing typologies.



The Dinterhaus was built in 1952 in Frankfurt am Main. In the following years it became a central production site for the global fur industry until its successive decline in recent decades.

Dinterhaus于1952年建于美因河畔法兰克福。在建成后的几年里，它成为了全球毛皮业的核心生产点，直到近几十年产量连年减少。





From 2017 to 2019 the Dinterhaus was converted into the NIKA.haus. It was transformed into a space for shared and affordable dwelling in the top floors and public use in the ground floor.



With our neighbours we work against the general gentrification and crowding-out processes within Frankfurt's diverse Central Station district.




